

Recreation Complex Opens Sept. 11

Mayor Rick Taylor will cut the ribbon at a ceremony to officially open the Pennsauken Community Recreation Facility at noon on Saturday, Sept. 11 at the complex on Westfield Avenue.

All residents are invited to the ribbon-cutting and ceremony, which will include honoring the victims of the Sept. 11, 2001 attacks and all U.S. military.

After the ceremony, family festivities will fill the whole complex and continue until 2 p.m. including a moon bounce, face painter and more.

The 23-acre facility includes seven lighted soccer fields, snack stand, picnic areas, large skate park for use with rollerblades and skate boards. A multi-use exercise path for walking and biking surrounds the whole facility. There is also a basketball court, playground with slides and ladders plus an area to hold outdoor concerts.
