## Larry Cardwell - Economic Development

Buckeye Terminal Block 1003, Lots 1,2,3,4,5,6,8,9 & 10 – this property has no significant violations. Buckeye Pennsauken Solar LLC – Is developing a solar photovoltaic system on approximately 100 acres. This project is in keeping with the ownership's commitment to reducing greenhouse gas emissions across its asset classes targeting net zero by 2050. The property is in an HI zone. The project will consist of 62,000 solar panels producing 20,000 kW AC and up to 28,000 kW DC. The area to be developed is designated as "Historic Fill" by the NJ DEP. The electricity generated will be tied in directly to a PSE&G circuit located on River Road just outside the Buckeye property. The entire area will be surrounded by a fence. (for more details see attached)

#### 2) Items for Discussion

#### Zoomvee 809 Hylton Road – this property has no significant violations.

Zoomvee – Would like to lease this 9,400 square foot warehouse to open a contactless digital pre-owned car buying company. The vehicle will be delivered to the customer after the online purchase, otherwise customers have the option of taking possession of the vehicle at the nearest Zoomvee location. All vehicles (50 - 60) at a time will be stored inside the warehouse. The vehicles will be fully serviced and detailed before arriving at the warehouse. The property is located in an LI zone.
