ORDINANCE NO. 2010:03

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF PENNSAUKEN AMENDING CHAPTER 269, SOLID WASTE REGULATING THE PLACEMENT OF YARD WASTE IN THE STREET

WHEREAS, the Township of Pennsauken is authorized to discharge

stormwater to surface water and groundwater in accordance the Tier A

Municipal Stormwater General Permit issued by the New Jersey Department of

Environmental Protection (NJDEP); and

WHEREAS, the NJDEP has revised the requirements of the Tier A Permit to

delete the seven (7) day restriction prior to scheduled collection for the placement of

uncontainerized yard waste in the street.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the

Township of Pennsauken, in the County of Camden and State of New Jersey, that the

Code of the Township of Pennsauken, Chapter 269, Solid Waste, Section 269-11,

General Regulation is hereby amended as follows:

Amend Section 269-11, Subsection D, now to read:

The sweeping, raking, blowing, or otherwise placing yard waste that is not

containerized within the cartway of the street is not permitted to be placed

within 10 feet from any storm drain inlet. Placement of yard waste in a manner

other than as described herein is a violation of this ordinance and shall be

removed by the party responsible for placement of the yard waste.
