

RESCINDING RESOLUTION 2023.274 AND AUTHORIZING THE CANCELLATION OF PROPERTY TAXES FOR WHO IS ENTITLED TO AN EXEMPTION DUE TO THE VETERAN ADMINISTRATION DETERMINATION OF 100% PERMANENTLY AND TOTALLY DISABLED.

WHEREAS resolution 2023.274 was adopted on August 7, 2023 with erroneous information concerning actual dates previously provided, and has been corrected and accepted, and

WHEREAS, The owner and resident of the below property has met all the requirements for a Totally Disabled Veteran Exemption as prescribed by New Jersey Statute 54:4-3,30 for exempt status until the applicant passes or the home is sold; and

WHEREAS, The owner ORTIZ, JOEL, owner of 50 Hamilton Court., also known as Block 2604.01 Lot 94, has applied to the Tax Assessor of The Township of Pennsauken for Tax Exempt Status and have been approved by the Tax Assessor of The Township of Pennsauken for Tax Exempt Status on January 17, 2023; AND

WHEREAS, The Tax Collector of The Township of Pennsauken recommends the cancellation of taxes for taxes for the year 2023 and preliminary 2024, for the listed property; AND

BE IT RESOLVED, That the taxes listed below shall be cancelled and that the Tax Assessor and the Tax Collector are herewith authorized and instruction to adjust their records accordingly; AND
