## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CANCELLATION OF PROPERTY TAXES FOR VETERAN WHO IS ENTITLED TO AN EXEMPTION DUE TO VETERAN ADMINISTRATION DETERMINATION OF 100% PERMANENTLY AND TOTALLY DISABLED

WHEREAS, ORITZ IVETTE Y & ALICEA CARLOS J owners and residents of 117 Kohlmyer Drive, also known as Block 2604.01, Lot 60, have opted out of the Payment in Lieu of Taxes (PILOT) on their property; thus ad valorem taxes would be due and owing on the property; and

**WHEREAS**, Ivette Y Ortiz is a 100% permanently and totally disabled veteran and has met all the requirements of the Veteran Administration for a Totally Disabled Veteran Exemption as prescribed by New Jersey Statute 54:4-3.30 for exempt status until the applicant passes or the home is sold; and

WHEREAS, IVETTE Y ORTIZ has applied to the Tax Assessor of The Township of Pennsauken for Tax Exempt Status and have been approved by the Tax Assessor of The Township of Pennsauken for Tax Exempt Status as of October 5, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, The Tax Collector for the Township of Pennsauken recommends the cancellation of taxes as of October 5, 2023 in the amount of \$1,402.78 and preliminary 2024 in the amount of \$2,822.78 and thereafter as long as the applicant meets veteran tax exempt status in reference to the above listed property; and

**BE IT RESOLVED,** That the taxes on the aforementioned list be cancelled and that the Tax Assessor and the Tax Collector are herewith authorized and instructed to adjust their records accordingly; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** That a certified copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to the Tax Assessor, Tax Collector and Chief Financial Officer; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** By the Township Committee of The Township of Pennsauken and State of New Jersey, that the exemptions are granted.
