

**PURCHASE OF BODY WORN CAMERAS EQUIPMENT THROUGH THE STATE OF
NEW JERSEY COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM NJSTART
STATE CONTRACT (AXON ENTERPRISE, INC CONTRACT 17-FLEET-00738)**

WHEREAS, The Township of Pennsauken wishes to purchase of Body Worn Cameras equipment for use by the Police Department from an authorized vendor under contract by the Division of Purchase and Property, Department of Treasury, State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, Axon Enterprise, Inc, has been awarded New Jersey State Contract Number 17-TELE-00738 for the purchase of body wore cameras equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has recommended the use of this contract, price and other factors considered; and

WHEREAS, the cost of this purchase shall not exceed \$250,000; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer of the Township of Pennsauken, as required by N.J.A.C. 5:30-1 has certified that there are sufficient funds available for the purpose of awarding a contract to said entity, to encumber funds against budget account C-04-23-100-201

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer of the Township of Pennsauken, as required by N.J.A.C 5:30-1, has certified that there are sufficient funds available for the purpose of warding a contract to said entity; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township Committee of the Township of Pennsauken, County of Camden and the State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. That Axon Enterprise, Inc, 17800 N. 85th St, Scottsdale AZ, 85255 be awarded a contract for the purchase of body wore cameras equipment, as recommended by the Police Chief, in an amount not to exceed \$250,000.
2. That the Township Committee hereby directs the Township Administrator, the Township Clerk, and the Purchasing Agent to execute any contract documents which are necessary to effectuate the terms of this Resolution, subject to review, revision, and approval by the Township Solicitor.
