As you may already know, PSE&G has been making repairs to its natural gas facilities on Rt. 70 at several locations between Cuthbert Rd and Rt. 38 in Cherry Hill and Pennsauken. The repairs are being done as a result of required surveys in the area.


Please note that the area inside your home or business and around your property has been deemed safe, and PSE&G personnel will continue to monitor the area to ensure the safety of all residents.

The final repairs are scheduled to begin on or about Monday, September 15th, 2014. During this phase of the project, it is necessary to work around the clock seven days a week to complete this project. PSE&G appreciates your patience and cooperation while we complete this final phase of the project.

PSE&G has spoken with both municipal and state officials, and will be working with both Cherry Hill and Pennsauken police on site to direct traffic. We will make every effort to minimize the work area. Although the roadway will remain open in both directions, it will be necessary to close the left lane west bound during construction.

Thank you in advance for allowing us to provide you with safe, reliable natural gas, and for your cooperation in this matter.
