Introduction

The Pennsauken Smoke Detector Program is designed to supply **free** smoke detectors to those households that meet **all** of the below listed qualifications. If you are in need of a working smoke detector, or know of someone who is and they currently meet the qualifications, please submit the attached application to the Fire Marshal's Office.

Qualifications:

1. Currently reside full time in the Township of Pennsauken and are not in the process of selling your property
2. Be a home owner. *(If you rent your home, including apartments, your landlord is required by law to provide working smoke detectors. If your landlord has not provided working smoke detectors, you may file a complaint with our office by calling 856-665-0774 extension 210)*
3. Be physically disabled, and/or a senior citizen with a fixed income. (proof may be required)

Please submit completed applications to the Fire Marshal's Office by facsimile at 856-662-0757, by visiting our office at 2215 Merchantville Ave, or by scanning and emailing the application to sschwegel@pennsaukenfire.org. After processing the completed application our office will contact you to schedule an appointment to install the smoke detector(s). An authorized adult at least 18 years of age must be on the premise to permit the inspector access to the home.
